





- Fogo, Twillingate, Moreton's Harbour: communities on Notre Dame Bay, NL
- Flake: a pole rack for drying fish
- Rinds: strips of bark, used to cover the drying fish
- Sods: pieces of turf, used to weight down the rinds
- Cakes: hard-tack biscuits

Roxanne Young's workshop (2011-02)

- Down-down bowing on any 1/4-1/8 pattern at the start of a measure
- Up-up bowing: on any 1/4-1/8 pattern at the end of a measure
- Drones: D&A strings on measures 02-08 & 10-16, G&D strings on measure 09 & 17
- Measures 10, 12, 15: Roll (1-3-1-A-1) on B note pairs at start of measure
